### **Small Business Success Stories**

KO Consulting successfully secured **two BWC Safety Intervention Grants** for **P&S Bakery** between August and October. The first grant, for ergonomic mats, totaled **\$1,672.61**, while the second, for electric pallet jacks, totaled **\$14,239.58**. In total, the BWC is covering \$15,912.19 in safety upgrades, enhancing workplace safety and efficiency for their facility.

KO Consulting identified opportunities within the **Inflation Reduction Act (IRA)** to help **P&S Bakery** secure reimbursable costs through tax credits. After coordinating with P&S leadership and the Accounting Team, P&S purchased a new forklift valued at **\$40,162.52**, which is expected to be a nearly **full reimbursement** via the IRA. Additional facility upgrades, such as HVAC replacements and lighting improvements, have been identified for IRA coverage in 2025. We are beyond excited to continue helping invaluable local businesses like P&S. secure funding.

KO Consulting, LLC. also has the privilege of working with Impeccable Air, an innovative indoor air quality solutions provider based in Boardman, Ohio, that has committed itself to enhancing air filtration in homes and other businesses. Its flagship product, designed by owner Dominic Pecchia, is a two-piece vent system engineered to transform traditional air vents into sophisticated air purification solutions that elevate both the aesthetics and the air quality of homes. Impeccable Air Vents are crafted from a premium composite material that ensures durability, resilience, and an aesthetically pleasing appearance. This material is chosen for its ability to resist dents, rust, and deformation, providing a long lasting solution that retains its elegance over time. We are excited to congratulate Dom and Impeccable Air for reaching a partnership agreement with the Home Depot. Dom's unique vents and services are now available for purchase across Home Depot's website. With big plans for Impeccable Air in 2025, we are excited to continue assisting small businesses further their scope of reach and development within the region.

#### **Government Success Stories**

**The City of Girard** received \$239,300 through the **Appalachian Regional Commission** for its Wastewater Treatment Plant. These funds will support installing a new pump station, alleviating overuse and strain on the current pumps to improve efficiency and reliability.

The Wellman Theater was awarded \$300,000 in **Ohio State Capital Bill** funding through Senator Sandra O'Brien's office for renovations. This historic site, located in the heart of downtown **Girard**, will be updated to enhance public use and enjoyment, preserving its vital role in the community.

**The City of Campbell** was awarded \$660,000 through the Ohio State Capital Budget for an access road project near the Community Literacy Workforce Cultural Center on Route 616. This project will promote economic development along Route 616 and provide an additional route for emergency services.



The City of Struthers received \$103,150 from the Ohio State Capital Budget to construct a splash pad in Mauthe Park, creating a new recreational space for the community.

#### Government Success Stories Continued ...

The Village of McDonald secured \$28,000 through the Bureau of Workers

Compensation (BWC) Safety Intervention Grant to purchase a fully mechanized Power

Cot System for its ambulance. This equipment will ensure safer and more efficient

ambulance operations.

John F. Kennedy Catholic School secured \$300,000 in Ohio State Capital Bill funding through Senator Sandra O'Brien's office. The funding will be used to renovate and upgrade the Upper Campus site, ensuring the school's future and enhancing the experience for its student body.

Weathersfield Local School District was awarded \$38,000 through the Department of Justice's COPS Program to upgrade its security cameras, enhancing safety for students and staff.



Through Norfolk Southern's Thriving Communities Grant program, KO Consulting, LLC secured \$50,000 for Youngstown State University's (YSU) Student Security Services Division. The funding was used to purchase an Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) accessible electric cart. This new cart enables the Division to conveniently transport students, faculty, staff, and visitors with wheelchairs to and from campus activities, ensuring greater accessibility and inclusion.

### **Non-Profit Success Stories**

YWCA Alliance and YWCA of Van Wert County were among the first recipients statewide to be awarded funds from OneOhio Recovery Foundation, which was created to distribute funds Ohio will receive from the pharmaceutical industry for its role in the opioid epidemic. Awarded \$92,520 and \$72,000 respectively, YWCA Alliance and YWCA of Van Wert County will use funding to provide evidence-based, wraparound support services to individuals with Substance Use Disorder.

KO Consulting secured more than \$30,000 in new funding for Tails of Hope to support program and capital expenses. The first and only non-profit spay / neuter clinic in Mercer County, PA, Tails of Hope provides low- to no-cost services across 32 counties in Western PA and Eastern Ohio, addressing the root cause of pet overpopulation and ensuring that essential veterinary care is accessible to all.

We secured nearly \$55,000 in private and government funds for Mahoning Valley Sojourn to the Past. As the only organization in the Mahoning Valley focused on educating the community about the Civil Rights Movement, MVSTP serves more than 1,500 individuals annually through year-round youth and community education programming.
